

Ruffle Hem

Measure across the raw hemline of your dress/skirt. Cut 2 strips of fabric 1.5x the width of your hemline and 6-8cm long. Place your two strips right sides together and sew down both short ends. Finish off the bottom raw edge of your strips with a fine rolled hem. Sew a line of stitching 5mm from the top raw edge of the band using a long stitch length and leaving long thread tails on both ends. Hold your bobbin thread and gently pull to gather the fabric. Pin evenly around the raw hemline of the dress aligning the side seams of both. Sew together 7mm from the edge. Overlock the edge and fold it behind the skirt/dress fabric. Topstitch in place 4mm above the seam.
